

## **Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission Report By ADR Staff**

Chairman John Longacre convened the August 8, 2017, session of the Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission (UMV&PC). Following roll call and approval of the July 2017 meeting minutes, Longacre called on Commission Director John Maile for his report.

Director Maile reported that the legislature is conducting an interim study on agency consolidation. According to legislative liaison Curt Roggow, the study will be addressing larger agencies. It is not expected that the UMV&PC will be a subject of the study.

Maile reminded the Commissioners that the staff will not be conducting audits during renewal season. Therefore, he has directed investigators to spend more time at the insurance salvage pools watching for unlicensed individuals.

Maile reported that the recent tornado in Tulsa had affected several dealerships. Some of those dealerships might not be able to continue operation.

Chief Investigator John Lancaster informed the Commissioners that staff had completed 25 inspections, conducted 0 audits, and had handled 26 complaints.

A total of 33 dealers attended the on-site education program. Applicants for a new license and dealers involved in significant rule violations are required to attend the Commission's education program as a part of acquiring or maintaining a state license. The education sessions are held in the first floor conference room at 421 NW 13th, Oklahoma City. Classes are held on Monday prior to the Commission meeting on the second Tuesday of each month. The sessions run from 9 a.m. to about noon or 1 p.m. Attendees are asked to make reservations so staff can be prepared to accommodate everyone.
