

**Emissions System Disclosure Reminder**

Effective November 1, 2003, the Oklahoma State legislature enacted a portion of law (Title 47 O.S. Section 12-423) that requires the emission system to be functioning properly before you may sell the vehicle. The Used Motor Vehicle & Parts Commission is using the following guidelines to determine compliance with the statute.

1. If you are selling the vehicle to another dealer, the system may be inoperable providing you disclose that fact to the purchasing dealer in writing or make an announcement at an auction.
2. If you are selling the vehicle at a public auction and the system is inoperable, only a licensed dealer may purchase the vehicle. Again, it must be announced prior to the sale.
3. If you are selling the vehicle to a consumer, you cannot disclaim the emission system. It must be operable and functioning properly. If the Commission receives a complaint you will be required to bring the system up to compliance or repurchase the vehicle.
